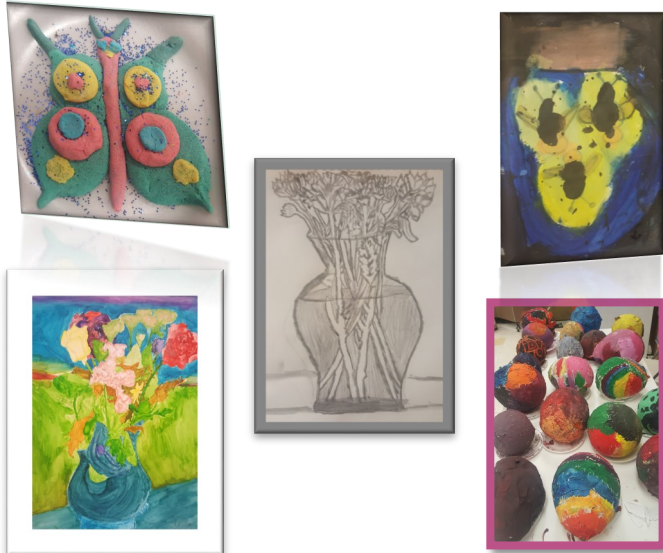

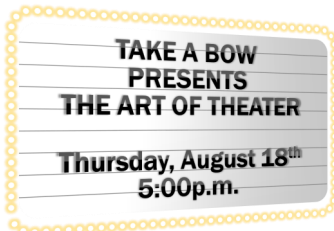
SUMMER DAY CAMP

REMEMBERING JUNIUS A. UNDERWOOD

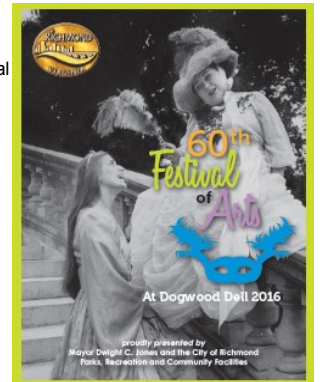
